

4. The City of San Diego will provide traffic control for the event. Two Police Officers have been requested on-site during the entire evening, and traffic controllers will be overseeing traffic needs on Catalina. Both Sunset View Elementary and Silvergate Elementary have been requested to provide their parking lots for the event. Old Town Trolley will provide a complimentary shuttle service to and from the park.
5. Because the concerts end at 8 p.m., the need for lighting is minimal. The bands will use one (1) hush generator to light the music stands, and for background stage lighting. There will be no stadium-type lighting installed. There will be lights for those using the stairs to exit the park.
6. There will be six portable restroom units available for concertgoers. They will be delivered on Friday afternoon and picked up on Saturday morning. A clean-up crew will clean up the picnic debris on Friday evening, and a trash company will remove all debris on Saturday morning.
7. If there is damage to the field, proceeds from the concert will be used to reseed the grass.
8. The San Diego Parks & Recreation Department has experience in understanding the requirements for making these concerts successful and enjoyable for all. A volunteer committee is working hard to address neighborhood concerns and to create a terrific summer series. Point Loma businesses and individuals are also generously funding this series through sponsorships and gifts.
